

The DDC is pleased to announce that property owned by the DDC at 724 and 726 SW Adams Street and 225 State Street has been sold to Baldovin Development who is currently developing the Adams & Oak property on the 800 block of SW Adams Street as well at The Center at 801 SW Adams Street. They have purchased this property in the 700 block of SW Adams Street

across from those two developments to provide adequate parking for their residents and commercial tenants. The DDC applauds Baldovin Development for this strategic move to help further their development in the Warehouse District.

Per the DDC bylaws, in making appointments to the Board, consideration is given to the needs of the Corporation, the potential appointee's experience, background and interest in the Corporation and economic development matters, and the benefits to the Corporation to be derived from the service of the appointee. No person who has a sustained conflict of interest between his own responsibilities and interest and those of the Corporation (e.g., being a developer in the downtown or rental property owner) shall be appointed to or remain on the Board of Directors. In addition to other appropriate qualifications, all persons appointed to the Board of Directors shall possess high civic ideals and shall vigorously represent the entity or district from which they have been selected.

Adams & Oak Update



According to Roxanne Ibe, Development Coordinator at Baldovin Development, construction at 800 SW Adams Street at Adams & Oak is coming along very well: "We have new windows throughout the building, all the framing and drywall is completed, and cabinets and paint is starting on the upper floors. We are on track to have residential tenants move in as early as the beginning of 2024. We already have a good-sized waiting list for apartments, so anyone who is interested in an apartment can email me to be added to the list. Folks on the list will get first choice of apartments once they become available." There is no deposit required to be added to the list.

Also, Baldovin Development is in talks with some very exciting commercial tenants, but has some commercial space available, ranging from 1400 sf - 5000 sf. They are looking for modern restaurant, office, and retail tenants for those remaining spaces. Cookies By Design




