
DDC Activities


New Development

Development Update


Bob Michel Bridge Improvements



The project to improve the Bob Michel Bridge began in the Fall of 2018, primarily to add a barrier protected bike/pedestrian pathway. A special thank-you goes out to Ray Lees, Planning Program Manager, Tri-County Planning Commission, for his vision and leadership on this project. The latest from Mr. Lees is that IDOT is planning on opening the bridge by Thanksgiving, fingers crossed! Although traffic is halted on the bridge while under construction, pedestrians and bicyclists are able to traverse the bridge between Peoria and East Peoria. The accompanying photos show the progress to date. It is looking good, especially with Cat tractors on the job! We are anxious to announce the reopening of the bridge, hopefully in November. This is an important safety upgrade for pedestrians and bicyclists who cross the bridge. Kudos to all involved!


Kenny's Westside Pub


Condos at 736 SW Washington Street

City of Peoria Updates

1. Two-way street restoration on Adams and Jefferson

This will be out to bid this fall. Work potentially starting this winter, but more likely in the spring.

2. Reversing the reverse parking

Work in progress and will be completed soon.

3. Wayfinding signs

The contractor has been on-site and is now manufacturing the signs. We should see sign installation starting this fall.

4. Parking study

Ongoing.

5. Downtown housing study
