
New Board Member

City Updates



One-Way to Two-Way Street Restoration

On February 26, construction work zones and traffic control was established on SW Adams Street between Walnut Street and Fulton Street to begin work on the two-way street restoration project. The project was approved last year by City Council to help the flow of traffic and to make it easier for pedestrians to access businesses in the area. Restrictions in the parking lane on the south side of SW Adams Street are present. These parking restrictions are clearly marked, and meters are bagged with "No Parking" signs. Additional parking and lane restrictions will be forthcoming as the Adams Street and Jefferson Avenue One-Way to Two-Way (OWTW) Conversion Project progresses. Construction began on Monday, March 4, at the intersection of N. William Kumpf Boulevard and SW Adams Street. Drivers should be mindful of workers in the area and watch for no-parking areas. Extra caution should be exercised in the area. We will keep you updated as work progresses.

2024 Commercial Renovation Grant

The city of Peoria is launching the 2024 Commercial Renovation Grant program on Monday, March 11 through Friday, April 5. This program, now in its third year, provides financial assistance for small businesses in the city of Peoria to make improvements to their commercial property.

Grants can range from \$5,000 to \$25,000 for projects that improve the interior or exterior of the business. Past recipients have been awarded funding for façade beautification, fixture upgrades, improved signage, painting, and flooring replacement, amongst others. Downtown Art Spotlight

Peoria Art Guild



For over 145 years, the Peoria Art Guild has been dedicated to "bringing art to the community and the community to art." As a visual arts leader, the Guild takes pride in its efforts to educate young artists, showcase art diversity, exhibit multidisciplinary contemporary art, and promote art throughout our community.

In September 2024, they will celebrate their 61st anniversary of hosting the Peoria Art Guild Fine Art Fair. It is one of the largest visual arts events in Central Illinois. This juried Art Fair features 130 local, national and international artists from all across the United States and numerous countries around the world. And the economic impact of last year's Fine Art Fair? \$324,553! Forty percent of attendees traveled over 25 miles. That is a nice infusion for our area!









In addition to the Fine Art Fair, the Peoria Art Guild offers a myriad of programs at their downtown location at 203 Harrison St., their newest location at the Grand Prairie Mall, and through community outreach. According to their 2024 annual report, "Our commitment to nurturing artistic talent is evident in the remarkable statistics from our Arts Education programs."

In 2023, they provided 381 art classes, offering an astounding total of 3,254 enriching art experiences. Among these, 155 childrens classes imparted 1,572 experiences of creative growth, while 272 adult classes sparked 1,702experiences.

This was all made possible through the dedication of 32 skilled art instructors who tirelessly shared their expertise.

Furthermore, they were able to extend one scholarship, granting an individual the opportunity to pursue their artistic aspirations. They also provided 46 FREE or deeply discounted art classes, creating 540 art experiences that enriched lives across our community with their Community Arts Program.

Their artisan gift shop featured 45 artists in the store in 2023 and sold \$5,000+ in local artisan's work. They are optimistic their 2024 stats will be even more impressive.

As you can see, the Peoria Art Guild offers so much! From the Sculpture Walk to Art and Music Camp to ongoing art education, the Guild supports students, artists, and enhances our entire community! 

Sculpture Walk Peoria Opening Day is May 18, 2024!

Sculpture Walk Peoria is currently accepting submissions for an outdoor sculpture exhibition running 2024-2026.

Sculpture Walk Peoria is a biennial, juried, outdoor exhibit offering local, regional, national and international sculptors opportunities to showcase and sell their creations, while enhancing the cultural environment of Peoria and providing opportunities to educate the public.

All sculptures are to be for sale. Since its inception, Sculpture Walk Peoria has sold 14 sculptures.

Sculptures will be placed in highly visible locations along Washington

Street in close proximity to the Peoria Art Guild and the Peoria Riverfront Museum which features over a dozen permanent pieces of outdoor public art. The Peoria Warehouse District has been included on the National Register of Historic Places.

Sculpture Walk Peoria is an initiative of the Peoria Art Guild with the support of the City of Peoria and private donors. They are seeking professional sculptures appropriate for public viewing from local, regional, national, and international artists. Sculptures are owned by the artist and loaned to the exhibit from May 18, 2024 through March of 2026. All sculptures must be made of materials that can withstand outdoor weather and not require any maintenance. The Honorarium is \$4,500 dollars, payable \$2,000 following the exhibit opening on May 18, 2024; \$2,000 May 2025, and \$500 at pickup of the sculpture. There will be an additional \$1,000 People's Choice Award given to one artist in May of 2025. Please visit www.peoriaartguild.com for more information.
